You must complete either of these qualifications to undertake CHC43121 Certificate IV in Disability Support.

- Completion of: CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) OR
- Completion of: CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Disability) OR
- Completion of: CHC30408 Certificate III in Disability PLUS the CHCSS00125 Entry to Certificate IV in Disability Support Skill Set.

This qualification is delivered over **34 weeks of study** which includes **30 weeks** of training and assessment and self-study (excluding **2 weeks of work placement**) and **4 weeks of holidays/study break** for self-place learning and reflection.

Disability Service Officer

Provides personalised support, develop individualised care plans to advocate for client's rights and needs



Disability Support Assistant

May care for, offer companionship and emotional support to clients in their homes or care facility.



Day Support Disability Officer

Provides day support while family caregivers carry out their usual duties.



Senior Disability Worker

Provides daily support including completion of a variety of daily tasks for an aging client.



Support Facilitator

Provides vital assistance to individuals with disabilities, monitor progress and coordinate support to meet client's goals and needs.
